After months of research and touring programs, they could not find exactly what they were looking for. So, they created their own! Over the years, Home Place has grown in size, but not In our core belief: God has a plan and purpose for every person.

Our programs include life skills training, social clubs, and volunteer site opportunities, which empower clients to achieve greater independence while actively engaging with the community. We also offer classes such as fitness, swimming, dance, cooking, and art. By partnering with families and local businesses, we ensure clients have access to a wide variety of enriching experiences that promote personal development. Each client receives an individualized monthly calendar, guiding their participation in diverse activities that align with their interests and goals.



# ADMISSIONS & ENROLLMENT

## Admissions Criteria:

To maintain a safe and enriching experience for all participants, prospective clients must meet the following qualifications:

- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Communicate verbally.
- Be ambulatory.
- Perform basic self-care.
- Not wander or run away.
- Respond to staff instructions.
- Demonstrate basic cooperation.
- Be willing to participate in both indoor and outdoor activities.
- Not require daily medical assistance or supervision beyond the capacity of non-medical staff.

## Enrollment Process:

Enrolling at Home Place of Texas is a simple process designed to ensure our program aligns with your needs or those of your loved one.

**Step 1:** Review our admission criteria thoroughly.

**Step 2:** Contact our Admissions Team to begin your inquiry.

**Step 3:** Schedule a family tour of our facility.

**Step 4:** Submit a completed application with a \$50 non-refundable application fee.

- Once your application is submitted, we will schedule a tour and observation week based on availability. Both the prospective client and a family representative must attend.

**Step 5:** If selected for an observation week, a \$225 fee will be due before the observation begins.

**Step 6:** After the observation week, you and the prospective client will meet with our staff for a brief consultation to discuss enrollment and the next steps.



# PAYMENT OPTIONS

## Private Pay:

Families paying out of pocket choose a 3, 4, or 5 day a week enrollment option. Fees are paid In advance by the 25th of the proceeding month.

- 5 Days: \$800
- 4 Days: \$700
- 3 Days: \$550

**Private Pay program hours are 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m.**

## Waivers:

Home Place of Texas is not a licensed provider of Waiver Services. However, we contract with agencies to allow our families to utilize their waiver funding (HCS, CLASS, TxHML) to attend Home Place under the Individualized Skills and Socialization (ISS) Program.

Home Place of Texas is currently licensed to provide ISS services only.

Fees are negotiated on a case-by-case basis with the waiver provider.

- **ISS program hours are 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.**
- **Extended care: \$5 per hour**
